III. Summary of API Scores

As stated in the UGC Regulations 2010, the API scoring will be progressively rolled out for categories I and II, beginning with assessment of one year for selection committees in 2010-2011, annual averages of two years in 2011-2012 and so on. But for Category III, scores will be computed for the entire assessment period as already indicated in the Regulations.

IV. Similar PBAS proforma could be developed by the universities for the Cadres of Librarian/Deputy Librarian/Assistant Librarian and Director of Physical Education & Sports/Deputy Director of Physical Education & Sports/Assistant Director of Physical Education & Sports based on the API Scoring pattern outlined in Appendix III: Table – IV to IX of the UGC-Regulations, 2010.
